

The Origin of Species: A Free Public Community Forum

On Monday, November 16 from 10:00 am to noon, the public is invited to a free presentation on *The Origin of Species* sponsored by the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI) at SOU. Bernard Hartman, Ph.D. will trace the history of Charles Darwin's theory of evolution by means of natural selection and cover the scientific controversy that immediately followed publication of his *Origin of Species* and that continues today. November marks the 150th anniversary of the publication of this seminal work.



Dr. Hartman previously served as Chair/Professor of Biological Sciences and Associate Dean of Sciences at Duquesne University in Pittsburgh, PA. Since his retirement in 2000 he has been an instructor and student at Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI) at SOU and is past president of the organization.
