Dr. Cynthia Hutton is Associate Professor of Music at Southern Oregon University and conductor of the SOU Wind Ensemble. She teaches classes in conducting, music theory, aural skills, brass methods and instrumental music education. In addition to these duties, Dr. Hutton is the Music Director of the Youth Symphony of Southern Oregon and has served as Conductor of the Youth Symphony and Youth Orchestra since 1995. As a horn artist, Dr. Hutton is a member of the Rogue Valley Symphony and the RVSO Brass Quintet. She has served on the boards of the Oregon Music Educators Association and the College Band Directors National Association - Northwest Division. Dr. Hutton is a recipient of the *Alteria M. Bryant Award* honoring women in the arts, as well as SOU's *Elmo Stevenson Presidential Award*. Dr. Hutton is in her twenty-first year of working at SOU and is an active clinician throughout Oregon and the region. She has appeared as guest conductor for the California All State Band and regularly serves as guest conductor throughout California and the Northwest region.
