Drew Wright is a performer, percussionist, and educator currently based in Ashland, OR. Drew earned his Bachelor of Music in Music Education from Ohio University and is currently working towards his Master of Music Performance at Southern Oregon University in Ashland, Oregon where he is a member of the contemporary percussion quartet Left Edge Percussion, an artist in residence at The Oregon Center for the Arts. He has performed extensively throughout the U.S. and Europe, performing in such cities as New York City, Los Angeles, San Francisco, Nashville, Washington D.C., Dublin, Ireland, and Rome, Italy, and can be heard on numerous recordings including two Grammy nominated albums, Mothership (2013) and Color + Light (2016). Most recently, Drew can be heard on Mark Applebaum's Speed Dating (2018). Whether through commissioning and premiering of new works, touring outside the concert hall, or presenting new works in educational and entertaining ways, Drew provides a fresh, nuanced view to contemporary music.
