# Transfer Agreement: Program of Study at Lane Community College

# Articulated with the School of Business at Southern Oregon University

Origination: Academic Year 2012-13 Until Revised or Terminated by LCC or SOU

It is agreed that students transferring from Lane Community College (LCC) to Southern Oregon University's (SOU) Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration will be given full credit for all selected courses listed on the attached schedule. Students following this program of study will have met SOU's lower-division general education requirements and will be eligible for admission to the School of Business. Students may be admitted to SOU with junior standing if they complete an Associate of Arts or Science Oregon Transfer Degree (AAOT or ASOT), or if they complete 90 transferable credits numbered 100 or above.

This agreement is based on the evaluation of the rigor and content of the general education and technical courses at both LCC and SOU and is subject to a yearly reevaluation by both schools for continuance. This version of the agreement shall remain in effect until revised or terminated by LCC or SOU.

Baccalaureate students must complete a minimum of 60 credits of upper division work before a degree will be awarded and meet all the requirements of SOU prior to graduation. Upper division is defined as 300- and 400-level classes at a bachelor's degree-granting institution.

Transfer students may guarantee their catalog of graduation by obtaining written approval from their SOU major department. The agreed upon catalog will be the one a student uses when he/she formally declares intent to complete this LCC-SOU Business Transfer Agreement, and commences the required coursework at LCC. Students must enroll at SOU within two years of this approval.
