It is agreed that students transferring from Mt. Hood Community College (MHCC), Associate of (Applied) Science with an emphasis in **Early Childhood Education** to Southern Oregon University's Early Childhood Development program will be given full credit for all selected courses listed below. This agreement is based on the evaluation of the rigor and content of the general education and technical courses at both MHCC and Southern Oregon University (SOU) and is subject to a yearly reevaluation by both schools. This version of the agreement shall remain in effect from November 28, 2011 until revised or terminated by MHCC or SOU.

Transfer students must guarantee their catalog of graduation by obtaining written approval from their 'SOU' major department and the Registrar. The agreed upon catalog will be the one a student uses when he/she transfers to SOU.

In order to utilize this agreement, students must be attending Mt. Hood Community College during the above catalog year and must enroll at SOU within three years of this approval.

Baccalaureate students must complete a minimum of **60** Upper Division *online credits* through SOU before a degree will be awarded. General education transfer requirements may be different than those required to earn an Associate of (Applied) Science degree and must be selected from the distribution listed under Southern Oregon University (SOU) below. Upper-division is defined as 300- and 400-level classes at a bachelor's degree granting institution.
