

## **Rogue Community College Associate of Applied Science Degree Programs to Southern Oregon University Bachelor of Applied Science in Management**

Revised June 2020

It is agreed that students transferring from Rogue Community College (RCC) in an Associate of Applied Science program to Southern Oregon University's (SOU) Bachelor of Applied Science in Management program will be given full credit for all selected courses listed below. This agreement is based on the evaluation of the rigor and content of the general education and technical courses at both RCC and SOU, and is subject to a yearly reevaluation by both schools for continuance. This agreement is dated May 2018.

Baccalaureate students must complete a minimum of 60 credits of upper-division work before a degree will be awarded. Upper-division is defined as 300-and 400-level classes at a bachelor's degree granting institution. Baccalaureate students at SOU must complete 45 credits from SOU before a degree will be awarded. To become admitted to the BAS program, students must hold an AAS degree outside the area of business with a GPA of 2.5 or better.

Transfer students may guarantee their catalog of graduation by obtaining written approval from their SOU major department and the Registrar. The agreed upon catalog will be the one a student uses when he/she transfers to SOU. Students must enroll at SOU within three years of this approval.

### **Course Requirements**

#### **Core Requirements for AAS to be taken at RCC**

##### **Total RCC AAS Tech credits 90**

Career Technical Coursework approximately 76 credits to be determined by the AAS degree pursued at RCC. Meet with an RCC advisor for details.

SOU accepts a maximum of 124 credits from a community college. The number of career technical credits applicable to this program will depend upon the number of credits a student transfers to satisfy the general education requirements. SOU's Bachelor of Applied Science in Management degree requires 180 total credits.

#### **Writing and Oral Communication**

It is recommended to complete the remaining Writing and Oral Communication courses at RCC before transferring to SOU but they can be taken at SOU. See an advisor for details.

SP111 Fundamentals of Public Speaking 3 credits

### **Mathematics 4 credits**

MTH 243 Introduction to Probability & Statistics 4 credits

This course can be taken at RCC or SOU, it is not required for the AAS degree at RCC but is a required course for the BAS degree at SOU.

### **Humanities 9-12 credits**

Three Humanities Courses from the SOU General Education Transfer Guide

### **Social Science 9-12 credits**

SOU requires three social science classes from an approved list. ECON 201 and ECON 202 are not required for the AAS degree at RCC but are required for the BAS program at SOU. PSY 101 or BA 101 is required for the AAS degree. Taking all three of these courses at RCC will satisfy the SOU Social Science requirements.

PSY 101 Psychology of Human Relations 3 credits

Or

BA 101 Introduction to Business 4 credits

ECON 201: Principles of Microeconomics 4 credits

ECON 202: Principles of Macroeconomics 4 credits

### **Science 11-15 credits**

Three Science courses from the SOU General Education Transfer Guide. Two courses must include labs.

### **Courses not required for RCC's AAS but are required for SOU's Bachelor of Applied Science in Management. These courses can be taken at RCC or SOU.**

BA 211: Financial Accounting I 4 credits

BA 213: Managerial Accounting 4 credits

BA 285 Advanced Business Applications Excel 4 credits

**Courses listed below are also required for the Bachelor of Applied Science in Management and are offered only by SOU.**
