# Rogue Community College (RCC) AAS Degree Programs to SOU's Bachelor of Applied Science in Management

Effective AY 2024/24 Revised Spring 2024

Core requirements for AAS to be taken at RCC Career Technical Course Work

Approximately 76 credits met by the AAS degree pursued at RCC. The BAS degree is designed for persons who hold a professional-technical associate's degree with a GPA of 2.5 or better. The AAS degree must be in a field other than Business or Accounting.

SOU accepts a maximum of 124 credits from a community college. The number of career technical credits applicable to this program will depend on the number of credits a student transfers to satisfy the SOU general education requirements. SOU's Bachelor of Applied Science in Management degree requires 180 total credits.

#### A guide to help meet the SOU lower division Capacity requirements with RCC transfer courses

To meet the Purposeful Learning Capacity component of the SOU lower division general education take the following courses:

WR 121Z Composition I

WR 122Z Composition II

and choose one of the following COMM courses:

COMM 111Z Public Speaking or COMM 218Z Interpersonal Communication or COMM 225 Small Group Comm & Problem Solving

The three courses transferred together will transfer to meet the Purposeful Learning requirement.

The other lower division Capacities are met by 1 course each at 3-5 credits. Each Capacity must be met by an approved course. Subject codes can only be used one time per Capacity. The subject code is the one assigned by SOU after the course transfer. See the <u>General Education Transfer Tools</u> to choose your courses. It is very important to work closely with an academic advisor to ensure the courses you choose help you meet SOU and RCC requirements.

COMM and WR are subject codes that can be repeated one time to meet a Capacity outside of Purposeful Learning. Since WR and COMM are required for Purposeful Learning to be met by transfer courses, the subject codes WR and COMM can be used once more to satisfy one of the other Capacities. For example, if a WR course is found to transfer as an SOU WR course that can meet the Communication

and Expression Capacity at SOU it can be used to meet this Capacity. But that will be the last time the WR subject code can be used to meet a Capacity
