

Associate of Science at Rogue Community College (RCC) Articulated with the Digital Cinema program at Southern Oregon University (SOU)

About the Program

This Associate of Science (AS) degree is based on a signed articulation agreement with Southern Oregon University (SOU). The program is designed for students transferring to its baccalaureate degree program in Digital Cinema. Students completing this degree will meet the requirements for the foundation courses within the Digital Cinema degree requirements. Students must work closely with advisors in their areas of interest to ensure electives are appropriate.

The curriculum allows for 45 core credits within the major area. By completing all appropriate credits (including electives), students will fulfill all of the required lower division general education coursework for transfer to SOU.

Students should be aware, however, that if they transfer before completing this degree, their courses will be evaluated individually toward the SOU degree and program they choose.

Students should contact the SOU Digital Cinema program early in the first year of the AS program to be advised about additional requirements and procedures for admission to the school or program. Students will be required to complete the SOU DCIN program requirements of DCIN 100 Career Foundations in DCIN and DCIN 203 Digital Cinema Production after transferring to SOU. These courses are only offered at SOU.

Entry Requirements

Students are required to take a placement test to determine skill level and readiness in math, reading, and writing. As part of their training program, students must begin with the courses within their skill levels as determined by placement test scores. In addition, students may also be required to enroll in classes that would increase their employability and success

Students who graduated from high school or completed a high school equivalency program in 1997 or after must have the following requirement for admission to a four-year Oregon state college or university: 1) two years of the same high school level language, or 2) two terms of college level language with a grade of "C" or better (may be first year language which can be used as elective credits). Students planning to complete a Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree at a four-year school will be required to complete the equivalent of one year of study of a foreign language at the second-year level (or above) before graduation.

Advanced Standing

Coursework from accredited universities will be accepted in accordance with college policies. To ensure that coursework is current, program courses over five years old must be reviewed and approved by the appropriate department chair before being accepted toward core requirements.

Graduation Requirements

The Associate of Science degree will be awarded to students who complete a minimum of 90 credits in this program with a grade of "C" or better. Certain required courses are also graded on a pass/no pass basis only. A grade of "P" for these courses indicates a student earned the equivalent of a "C" or better grade.

Choose one of the following ways to complete SOU's lower division general education Capacity requirements.

1. Complete the requirements for the Oregon Transfer Module at RCC.
2. Complete the AAOT or ASOT requirements at RCC.
3. Work closely with an academic advisor to complete courses at RCC that will meet the SOU lower division general education Capacity requirements.

SOU Lower Division General Education Capacities

Purposeful Learning Requirement:

The following Lower Division General Education Capacities may be met with courses required for the AS degree. Be mindful when choosing courses to meet the Capacities that are not met by required courses for the AS. Subject codes cannot be repeated. The subject code is the one assigned once the course transfers to SOU regardless what subject code was assigned at RCC. Work closely with your advisor to find the courses that best fit your path.

Communication and Expression 1 course 3-4 credit

*ART 131 will meet this requirement.

Creativity and Innovation 1 course 3-4 credits

*MUS 208 Film Music will meet this requirement.

Inquiry and Analysis 1 course 3-4 credits

Take 1 course at 3-4 credits that is approved for LDIA from the [SOU General Education Transfer Guide](#).

Numerical Literacy 1 course 3-4 credits

Take 1 course at 3-4 credits that is approved for LDNL from the [SOU General Education Transfer Guide](#). MTH 105Z is recommended

Equity Diversity and Inclusion 1 course 3-4 credits

Take 1 course at 3-4 credits that is approved for LDDI from the [SOU General Education Transfer Guide](#).
