

Tested positive for Covid-19

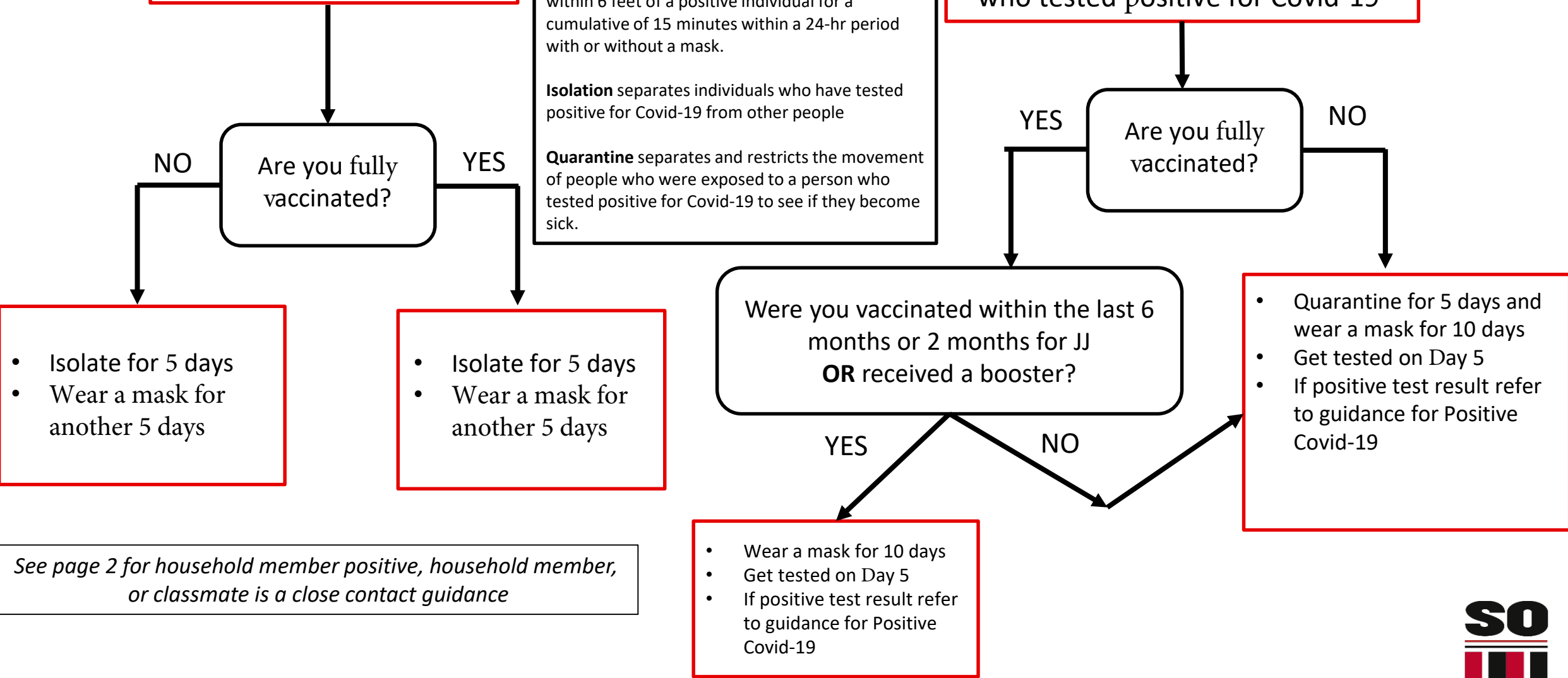
KEY DEFINITIONS

Close contact/exposed is an individual that was within 6 feet of a positive individual for a cumulative of 15 minutes within a 24-hr period with or without a mask.

Isolation separates individuals who have tested positive for Covid-19 from other people

Quarantine separates and restricts the movement of people who were exposed to a person who tested positive for Covid-19 to see if they become sick.

Close contact/exposed to someone who tested positive for Covid-19

Household member (roommate, family member, significant other, etc.) tests positive for Covid-19

Are you fully vaccinated?

NO

- If you can completely separate from the household member:
 - Quarantine for 5 days and wear a mask for 10 days.
 - Get tested on Day 5
- If you cannot separate from the positive household member, remain home during the isolation period (5 days) of the positive person.
 - After isolation of the positive household member, begin a 5-day quarantine
 - Get tested on Day 5
- If positive test result refer to guidance for positive Covid-19

- If fully vaccinated (vaccine + booster), wear a mask for 10 days and get tested on Day 5

Household member (roommate, family member, significant other, etc.) is a close contact/exposed to someone who tested positive for Covid-19

This means you are a contact of a contact and do not need to follow any restrictions.

- UNLESS the household member tests positive.
 - THEN follow the "household member tests Positive for Covid-19 guidelines".

My classmate/friend was in contact with someone who tested Positive for Covid-19

This means you are a contact of a contact and do not need to follow any restrictions.

- UNLESS the classmate/friend tests positive.
 - THEN follow the "close contact/exposed to someone positive for Covid-19 guidelines" (pg. 1)
