### **Academic Robes and Regalia**

The history of academic dress dates back to the Middle Ages when many of the scholars were also clerics and wore the robes of their monastic orders. In 1321, the University of Cambridge adopted specific styles and color combinations for its faculties. American colleges and universities desired to adopt a standard code of academic dress. At a conference held at Columbia University in 1895, representatives from various institutions adopted a code and regulations governing academic dress for colleges and universities in the United States. The standards continue to be followed by the American Council on Education.

The regalia worn today are traditional, and their colors, trimmings, and patterns represent the degree, the field of learning, and the institution which conferred that degree. The bachelor's gown has long pointed sleeves and designed to be worn closed; the master's gown has an oblong sleeve open at the wrist. The rear part of the oblong shape is square cut, and the front part has an arc cut away. The doctor's gown has bell-shaped sleeves, is faced with velvet, and has three bars across the sleeves. The color of the velvet is distinctive to the degree.

The hood also tells a story. The type of degree (Bachelor's, Master's, Doctor's) is indicated by the width of the velvet edging and the length of the hood, the doctor's hood being the longest and of a fuller shape than the others. The color of the velvet edging indicates the field of learning, and the colors of the lining designate the school which conferred the degree. The color of the tassel, worn on the left side of the mortarboard, also indicates the field of study and is gold for those with doctor's degrees.

The colors you will see today in the hoods and gowns of our faculty represent the various fields of learning:

Arts, Letters, Humanities: White

Music: Pink

Business Administration: Drab

Nursing: Apricot Education: Light Blue

Science: Gold Fine Arts: Brown

Certification of the conferral of a degree is by receipt of a diploma or official transcript noting degree completion, not necessarily participation in the commencement ceremony.

#### E. Robert (Bobby) Arellano

E. Robert (Bobby) Arellano has taught at Southern Oregon University for over a decade and was part of the founding faculty of the Emerging Media and Digital Arts program, where he instructs classes in innovation and leadership, digital media and art, writing, and storytelling. His classes are innovative and responsive to emergent trends and are dedicated to equity, diversity, and inclusion. Arellano's passion for and dedication to student success is apparent to all, and he is widely regarded as one of our university's most dynamic professors. #### 2022 Distinguished Service Award

#### Dr. David Bithell

Dr. David Bithell is a Professor of Art and Emerging Media and has worked at Southern Oregon University since 2011. A respected artist and composer, he is regarded as an innovative, regenerative, and inspiring campus leader, and has served the university in several capacities, including as program chair on the Faculty Development Committee, and as chair of the Faculty Personnel Committee. He

is respected for his organization, ability to build consensus, organization, and sensitivities across several issues. He is respected for his collegiality and hard work, and, as one colleague states, he is a freakishly polymathic workhorse.

#### Dr. Alena Ruggerio

Dr. Alena Ruggerio is a Professor of Communication, Media, and Cinema and has taught at Southern Oregon University since 2002. Dr. Ruggerio's service to the university and the larger community has been exemplary; she has served as program chair for Communication, chair of the Gender, Sexuality, and Women's Studies Council, president of the Friends of Hannon Library, chair of the Faculty Development Committee, the General Education Task Force, and co-facilitator of the Anti-Racism and Decolonization Innovation Community, among many other duties. In her commitment to serving others and to serving our campus as well as her humility in all that, Dr. Ruggerio is an exemplar for us all.

### 2022 Distinguished Scholarship Award


#### Dr. Alison Burke

Dr. Alison Burke is a Professor of Criminology and has taught at Southern Oregon University since 2008. Dr. Burke is a tireless scholar who consistently utilizes her research into her teaching. A Fulbright Scholar, Dr. Burke has published two books as the sole author, collaborated with the Criminology & Criminal Justice faculty on an Open Education Resource textbook used by SOU students, as well as authoring ten peer-reviewed articles on pedagogy, juvenile justice issues, and criminological theory. By any measure exceptional, Dr. Burke is one of SOU's premier scholars.

#### Dr. Mark Axel Tyeskov

Dr. Mark Axel Tveskov is a Professor of Anthropology and has taught at Southern Oregon University since 1998. In addition to his work teaching in Sociology and Anthropology and Military Sciences, Dr. Tveskov serves as a consulting anthropologist for the Confederated Tribes of Coos, Lower Umpqua, and Siuslaw Tribe, The Coquille Tribe, the Confederated Tribes of Siletz, and the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde. His scholarship focuses on the era of settler colonialism in southern Oregon, and this August, his edited volume on the historical memory of war and conflict will be published by the University Press of Florida. His current research includes historical research for the Maxville Heritage Center on the experience of rural African American Oregonians and also into the 1847 Battle of Buena Vista in Saltillo, Mexico.
