Graduating with a Degree at SOU

Degrees are awarded four times per year at the end of each term. An annual commencement ceremony is held in June and all degree candidates with approved applications for Fall through Summer terms of that academic year are eligible to participate.

You must apply for your degree to be awarded. You should apply in advance to allow sufficient time for application processing and adjustment to course schedule as necessary.

Degree Application Schedule

Fall 2025: still accepting applications; submit asap
Winter 2026: Available 10/20/25 - Priority Deadline 11/30/25*
Spring 2026: Available 12/23/25 - Priority Deadline 02/02/26*
Summer 2026: Available 03/09/26 - Priority Deadline 04/13/26*
Fall 2026 dates & graduation process will be updated before May 2026.

- Apply during the priority deadline window!
- Graduation term = last term of classes



Before applying you must have a “Graduation Plan”



Your plan must include:

- 1) Future courses ONLY
- 2) Start fresh! Don't use old plans
- 3) Make sure credits per term are correct!
- 4) Add a note to your plan to clarify missing requirements or substitutions
 - Transfer courses
 - Incomplete grades
 - Doesn't have to be active
 - Adjust credits for variable level courses

Before you create a graduation plan, you should meet with your advisor or Student Success Coordinator to see what courses you need to complete.

**** Creating a Graduation plan is a requirement for the graduation application. ****

- DO... Create a NEW plan with just future classes (the planner tool will already look at past classes and current registration)
- DO ... Use the NOTES feature to attach comments to your plan if you have transfer coursework or to clarify missing requirements

5 Steps to Graduate with a Bachelor's Degree

1. Create a Graduation Plan

Before submitting the online application, you should meet with your advisor to verify the remaining requirements and develop a graduation course completion plan.

Use the "Plans" feature in [DegreeWorks](#), and your plan will be used for degree evaluation.

**Failure to provide a clear and accurate plan will affect your degree evaluation. Please don't wait to be notified of degree deficiencies, your plan must address all remaining degree requirements as outlined in DegreeWorks (total credits, upper division credits, university strands, major/minor/cert requirements, etc).*

2. Apply for Your Degree

Learn How to apply for a degree at SOU. Access your student account and apply to graduate. Students can login to their student account and complete the application for a degree at least two terms before they expect to complete all the requirements for a degree.

How to avoid processing delays

Have a thorough course plan in Degreeworks - make sure it's named "GRADUATION PLAN" and only has FUTURE courses

Make sure plan (*or registration*) will resolve 180 total credit minimum, 60 UD credits, GE, major, minor and cert

Apply during the priority window - start planning now!

If I have to stop and question..

Don't wait for me to find degree problems!

- A. Due to the volume of spring applications it can take 5-6 weeks** to go through each application, and review each graduation course plan. = Apply during the priority window
- B. Be pro-active and do not wait to be alerted of incorrect or missing information** (otherwise you may not have time to fix your registration).
- C. Work with your advisors** to ensure your graduation plan will meet all missing requirements for your degree.

Deficient Application Process

If your registration and/or grad plan of future courses will not complete your degree OR you are missing cert applications ...

1. We document deficiencies in Degreeworks NOTE section
2. Email the student
3. Alert their major advisor via an internal deficiency tracking sheet
4. Student & Advisor must resolve deficiencies together
5. Advisor signs off on the deficiency tracking sheet
6. Graduation team will re-check the degreeworks and notes and approve if applicable




Check DegreeWorks

- Major, Minor, Cert requirements
 - Compare against the catalog/use correct catalog year
- If Degreeworks shows **“incomplete”** and 97% or less, then talk with your advisors!
- ***Check after registration changes***

Degreeworks can SHUFFLE courses!!

- Your pdf can help figure out what changed!

REPEATS = be CAREFUL!

- Courses are NOT repeatable for credit unless stated in the course description
- Sometimes you need to repeat for a better grade; you cannot earn credit for both classes
- Always watch for (R) next to registered for current & future registered classes
 - Degreeworks should exclude repeat registered course **BUT not always**
- Repeating classes = **risk of incorrect credit totals** and credits *might* change after grades are posted.

The planner audit will not “catch” duplicate repeat courses and will give incorrect audits (*especially when you have past terms in the plan*);

Check repeats when you register to ensure you will have over 180 total credits and >60 UD credits and that prev repeat is in the insufficient section

Know your course history!

This is your degree! We need you to be an expert in what classes you've completed, what your missing requirements are

- Check for course renumbering issues - psy 201 vs psy 201z etc
- Be careful not to repeat a class at SOU that you earned transfer credit for
- General Education - **Degreeworks is NOT perfect in applying GE classes**
 - Check your course history and work with advisors as needed to swap assigned classes
 - Single Subject Prefix --- Each class must have a different prefix for each GE capacity
 - Ex. cannot have two BA classes, even if they are 200/400 level
 - UD GE classes - cannot share a prefix with lower division class prefix

BA 409 - Internship (for BA/BS Majors)



1 to 12 credits

Provides an opportunity to apply academic concepts in real-world work settings, including for-profit, nonprofit, and government organizations (approved by the School of Business Internship Coordinator). Internships are usually conducted during senior year and must be approved prior to start of work experience. Students must have a GPA of at least 2.5 in BA courses and have completed all appropriate coursework in the major. For BA 409, 4 credits represents 120 hours in the workplace. Repeatable for a maximum of 12 credits. Students must register for the appropriate number of credits at the time of registration. Prerequisite(s): Junior standing or above and [BA 324](#), [BA 330](#), [BA 374](#), [BA 380](#), [BA 382](#), [BA 386](#).

Grade mode designated on a CRN basis each term. Students should consult current term schedule.

Reference your major in the catalog in conjunction with Degreeworks

Check Credits & Grade Mode

- Use Caution with variable credits (1-18 credits)
 - Check accurate credit amounts per course in the Planner
 - Always check registration credits vs. course requirement
 - (eg. 1 cr BA 409 vs. 4 credits)
- P/NP grades - usually do not count towards your major
- **Always look at Degreeworks after you register AND after grades are posted!**

GPA requirements

They can vary! Know GPA requirements for language, BS math/logic, major, cert, etc

Double Check! Degreeworks may not be clear, but your catalog for your major and cert should be

Examples:

BS math /logic require C- or higher

Most Certs require C or higher grade - but not all!

Most majors have a GPA and minimum grade requirement

Check the catalog!

Deficient GPA = I cannot award your degree

DFL = deficient foreign language

If you see this alert in your Degreeworks, you must:

1. Submit HS transcripts to SOU Admissions
- OR**
2. Complete 2 college level 101/102 language courses
3. It will be a barrier to graduation

Finishing over the Summer ??

- Yes you can walk in June ceremony, but
- Must be registered in Summer courses to demonstrate you will finish
- **Apply for a Summer degree, NOT spring >3/9/2026**
 - your graduation term is Summer if that is when you will finish ALL requirements
- All incompletes must be resolved before you can graduate

Students finishing in Fall 2026 will have a different application process

- Last names are official record AND require formal name change form & documentation

Institutional Honors

Honors at Commencement:

The SOU Institutional GPA at the end of Winter term determines eligibility for honors cords and recognition in the program:

Cum Laude: 3.50 to 3.74

Magna Cum Laude: 3.75 to 3.89

Summa Cum Laude: 3.90 to 4.00

Honors on Transcripts & Diploma:

The Institutional GPA after final term of courses determines the final and official GPA to appear on transcripts and diploma.
