# Academic Robes and Regalia

The history of academic dress dates back to the Middle Ages when many of the scholars were also clerics and wore the robes of their monastic orders. In 1321, the University of Cambridge adopted specific styles and color combinations for its faculties. American colleges and universities desired to adopt a standard code of academic dress. At a conference held at Columbia University in 1895, representatives from various institutions adopted a code and regulations governing academic dress for colleges and universities in the United States. The standards continue to be followed by the American Council on Education.

The regalia worn today are traditional, and their colors, trimmings, and patterns represent the degree, the field of learning, and the institution which conferred that degree. The bachelor's gown has long pointed sleeves and designed to be worn closed; the master's gown has an oblong sleeve open at the wrist. The rear part of the oblong shape is square cut, and the front part has an arc cut away. The doctor's gown has bell-shaped sleeves, is faced with velvet, and has three bars across the sleeves. The color of the velvet is distinctive to the degree.

The hood also tells a story. The type of degree (Bachelor's, Master's, Doctor's) is indicated by the width of the velvet edging and the length of the hood, the doctor's hood being the longest and of a fuller shape than the others. The color of the velvet edging indicates the field of learning, and the colors of the lining designate the school which conferred the degree. The color of the tassel, worn on the left side of the mortarboard, also indicates the field of study and is gold for those with doctor's degrees.

## **Distinguished Teaching Awardee**

Additionally, she has developed engaging online versions of her courses to increase access for students who live and work in rural, distant settings of our Southern Oregon region and beyond. Her students frequently note that they feel heard, are challenged with relevant, engaging instruction, and perhaps most telling of all – that they want to teach like Tanya.

## **Distinguished Service Awardee**

### **DR. RENE ORDONEZ**

Dr. Rene Ordonez is recognized for his distinguished service to Southern Oregon University and the School of Business over more than three decades. During this time, he has made significant contributions to strengthening academic programs, advancing accreditation and assessment efforts, and supporting curriculum development and student success. In addition, his long-standing collaboration with the University of Guanajuato has expanded international learning opportunities and enriched the academic community. Beyond his university service, he has contributed to the broader community through board service and youth-focused initiatives. His sustained leadership, dedication, and commitment to continuous improvement have had a lasting impact on the institution, making him a deserving recipient of the Distinguished Service Award.

## Distinguished Scholarship Awardee

### DR. SHANELL SANCHEZ

At SOU, Dr. Shanell Sanchez has produced a diverse and voluminous portfolio of original scholarship within the field of criminal justice. Her work broadly addresses racial and ethnic disparities in the criminal justice system and gives voice to marginalized people and various community stakeholders. Furthermore, Dr. Sanchez admirably creates opportunities for SOU students to engage in meaningful scholarship, co-author published work, and present at conferences—helping them to prepare for meaningful careers and professional success. Dr. Sanchez’s work has appeared in diverse venues, including multiple open-access textbooks and educational resources, original qualitative research within peer-reviewed journals, and edited scholarly volumes. She is co-editor of the volume, *Exploitation and Criminalization at the Margins: The Hidden Toll on Unvalued Lives* (2024), and she has produced and co-authored multiple open-access educational resources to support educators and students in her field, including *Race, Crime, and Injustice* (2025) and *Introduction to the American Criminal Justice System* (2018). Through meaningful collaborations with students, colleagues, and the community, Dr. Sanchez’s work has supported the growth of reflexive and empathic capacities that the world needs, and has deeply inspired and enriched the SOU community.
